Biographies

Erica Burman is Professor of Education at the University of Manchester and a graduate of the Group Analysis North professional training in Group Analysis. She works on the Counselling Psychology professional doctorate in Manchester University and is currently the Convenor of the GAN Friday Seminars, as well as being a member of the Power, Position and Privilege committee of the Institute of Group Analysis, and various other of its subgroups.

Sue Einhorn is a Training Group Analyst with the IGA and has a private clinical practice where she conducts groups and sees people individually, face-to-face primarily. She supervised groups at Freedom from Torture (FFT) and was the Convenor for the IGA/OGRA Training in Group Analysis in St. Petersburg. Since 2015, Sue has conducted a supervision group for senior group analysts in Russia. From 2011-2018 she supervised experienced Group Analysts in Norway and was elected on to the Management Committee of GASI where she was Chair of the Scientific Programmes Committee until 2018. Sue currently supervises at Boabab, in Aarhus, Denmark and in India and is also conducting a Training Course in Group Analysis in Singapore. Sue writes occasional articles and gave the 2021 Foulkes Lecture. She is a member of the Power, Position and Privilege committee at the IGA and has set up a Fanon Reading Group under its' auspices.
